

AJK'S TAEKWONDO

Uniform Requirements

You may wear the uniform that was issued to you on the days that we have TKD, or just your TKD pants with a plain shirt or sweatshirt. Shirts are to be tucked in, with your TKD belt tied around your waist. If the weather is cold, sweatshirts may be worn over top. Your uniform is not to be worn outside of training or practicing the art of martial arts.

All students are required to wear the school patches on their uniform after the first rank examination. All contestants must wear a white Taekwondo V-neck uniform or dobok. Patches, logos, team names, country names, athlete names, and stripes are allowed on the uniform. Uniforms are allowed to have one patch, embroidery, team logo, athlete name, or country name up to 12" by 4" on each extremity (leg or arm) for a total of four. Logos or names on the back of the uniform and patches on the chest area of the uniform are also allowed. However, USA Taekwondo retains the right to make an athlete change their uniform top or pants if it is found to be derogatory or inflammatory in any way. In an effort to allow an athlete to have their own unique style, AJK's TKD will allow the athlete to place TKD patches of their choice on competition uniforms only.
